BOROUGH COUNCIL WORK SESSION Thursday, May 21, 2026 (7:00 pm)

Borough Council Vice President Daryl Littlefield called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Present were Councilors Bencsik, Costa, Rogers, Littlefield, Richter, and Mayor Yocum. Also present were Solicitor John Torrente, Chief OBrien, Sergeant Lukens, and Manager Sara Jarrett-Eaton. Absent were Councilors Sholly, Dill, Cross, and Munden. Councilor Littlefield announced that council had met in executive session prior to the meeting to discuss potential litigation.

Special Presentation- Ms. Deb Wellington- Ms. Wellington provided a presentation regarding North Penn Goodwill, services they provide, and the previous and current funding support status from Souderton Borough.

Public Comment- Ron Nichol- Mr. Nichol expressed frustration with the current trash and recycling collection process and the expense.

3. Recreation Items – Mrs. Jarrett-Eaton provided a brief update on the upcoming pool season and park pavilion rental.

5. Administrative Items-

a. Consideration of Finance Service Proposal

Councilor Costa made a motion to approve the proposal for service from Caselle for professional financial services at a cost of \$1,500.00 per month subject to an agreement acceptable to the Borough Manager. The motion was seconded by Councilor Rogers and passed unanimously.

6. Requested Action Items- Councilors, Borough Solicitor, and the Borough Manager discussed the presented trash and recycling bid specifications and the objectives that they hoped to accomplish in the bid solicitation. The bid specifications were not considered for approval and will be revised at the June 1st meeting of council after some revisions and additional considerations.
